Dates: Wednesday 6th to Saturday 9th March 2024 (3 nights, 4 days)


Participants: max. 5 international journalists


Ski touring in Valais.

If you love winter, you'll love Valais! The majestic four-thousanders not only create impressive panorama, they also provide a unique setting in which to experience winter sports. The possibilities are endless and snow is guaranteed. That's because Valais has the highest-altitude ski regions in Switzerland and can therefore offer a unique guarantee of snow on over 2,000 kilometres of pistes.

It is the pure tranquillity, the intimate encounter with nature, that makes ski touring so special. No matter how strenuous the climbs, the subsequent descents through glorious powder snow more than repay every effort. However, anyone wishing to explore these pristine snowscapes away from the marked pistes should do so only in the company of a mountain guide with local knowledge. Valais numbers 450 such guides, ready to lead guests through the winter wonderland with charm and skill, sharing their extensive knowledge along the way.

Valais is home to 45 peaks higher than 4,000 metres, which provide a spectacular backdrop to an incomparable playground for winter sports enthusiasts. This is regularly the setting for ski touring world championships as well as the world's toughest ski touring race, the Patrouille des Glaciers. The discipline of ski touring is enjoying tremendous growth in popularity: ascents across pristine white landscapes and thrilling descents over untouched fields of powder snow promise a boundless sense of freedom. The secured "Touring Tracks", meanwhile, offer the perfect introduction for novices.

Valais is home to 11 ski touring parks – at Les Marécottes, Les Giettes, Vercorin, Verbier, Torgon, St-Luc, Nendaz, Veysonnaz, Morgins, Arolla, and Crans-Montana. This number will no doubt grow in the coming years because ski touring is becoming more and more popular.



Val d'Hérens

The Val d'Hérens extends from the Rhône Valley near Sion to the foot of a string of snow-capped peaks including the Dent Blanche, Dent d'Hérens, Mont Collon and Mont Blanc de Cheilon. Ancient villages of typical Valais houses perch on the steep slopes.

Mountain-lovers, hikers, adventure enthusiasts and all who enjoy traditions and conviviality are in their element here. The village of Nax occupies a high, sunny balcony at an altitude of 1,286 m in the heart of Valais and enjoys majestic panoramic views. From here, visitors can explore the Val d'Hérens and its many sights, and get to know this land of ancient barns, living traditions, Raclette cheese and Fendant wine. The people of Evolène are particularly proud of their traditions: local women still wear traditional costume to church on Sunday. The region extends all the way to the mountains on the Italian border, framed by sparkling summits that culminate in the region's highest point, the Dent Blanche (4,357m). The idyllic setting – pristine glaciers, the river Borgne flowing through the valley, the majestic summits – makes for an unforgettable holiday backdrop.
